

# Warwickshire Championships

## General Conditions

**1 Dates and venues** – The dates and venues of Championships and Competitions shall be approved by the Executive Committee of the Association. Championships shall not be held on Sundays except by the approval of the Executive Committee.

## **2 Entries**

2.1 Entries will only be accepted from clubs or members of clubs which have paid their affiliation fee for the current year.

2.2 No competitor shall be entered in the name of more than one club in any one year's Championships for a single discipline.

2.3 See separate disciplines for their own specific entry conditions.

**3 Officials** – The appointment of all technical officials for championships shall be made by the appropriate Technical Committee in accordance with current ASA Laws and either ASA Technical Rules or FINA Technical Rules and any promoter's conditions which may apply.

**4** Any question arising in connection with the Championships, but not concerning ASA Laws and either ASA Technical Rules or FINA Technical Rules or the promoter's conditions, shall be referred to the Executive Committee whose decision shall be final.

## **5 Eligibility**

5.1 The Championships shall be open to all ASA Registered members of clubs affiliated to the Association provided they were born within the Association boundaries or have been resident therein continually before and since January 1st in the year of competition. In all cases eligibility will require the competitor's 'fee-paying club', as shown on the ASA registration database, to be a club affiliated to Warwickshire ASA

5.2 A swimmer not having a birth or residential qualification may apply to the Executive for permission to compete in Warwickshire Championships, providing he/she is also a member of a club affiliated to the Association and has not competed in the Championships of any other county in the year of competition.

5.3 No person shall be allowed to compete in this Association's Championships if also competing in any championship of another county in the same discipline during the same year of competition.

5.4 Competitors may be required to produce their ASA Registration Cards on demand or within seven days.

**6** Any competitor failing to comply with any general or specific condition governing a championship shall be disqualified and shall forfeit any fee which may have been paid .

## **7 Trophies**

7.1 The winner of a Championship shall be entitled to hold the Trophy for that Championship until called on by the Trophy Controller to return it.

7.2 All Trophies must in any case be returned to the Trophy Controller by 1st February.

## **8 Awards**

8.1 Individual and Team Championships: the medals struck by the Association's die will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all Championships

8.2 Age Group Individual and Team Events: other un-engraved medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
